

*Abstract*

The present study examined maladaptive sexual behaviors among Chinese psychiatric patients with anxiety disorders. Subjects included 294 anxiety disorder patients recruited from twelve hospitals from Mainland China and Hong Kong. Patients completed CPAI-2 under the supervision of participating psychiatrists. Findings indicated that there is no difference in sexual maladjustment among different groups of anxiety disorder patients. Gender difference is found on the sexual preoccupation subscale. Males have more problems than females. Result will be discussed in the context of Chinese culture.
