are qualified to apply for postgraduate research and professional training programmes, e.g., MPhil / PhD in Psychology, Clinical Psychology, Educational Psychology, Counselling Psychology, and Industrial-Organizational Psychology

Programme Structure

Students are required to complete a total of <u>30 units</u> following either the Research stream or the Applied stream.

- For the Research stream,
 30 units are made up of 24 units for successful completion of 8 required academic subjects, and a 6-unit independent study.
- For the Applied stream,
 - 30 units are made up of 24 units for successful completion of 8 required academic subjects,
 - a 3-unit capstone project, and
 - a 3-unit elective course on 1 out of 2 elective courses

Qualifications for Admission

Possess a Bachelor's degree (NOT majoring in psychology) from a recognized university

A personal statement in English (word limit: 400 words) stating how a study in psychology contributes to your career development or personal growth

General qualifications required by the Graduate School

Fulfill the "English Language Proficiency Requirement"

English Language Requirements for Admission



To fulfill the University's minimum English language requirements for admission to postgraduate programmes, applicants should have:

- 1. obtained a degree from a university in Hong Kong¹ or taken a degree programme of which the medium of instruction was English; or
- 2. achieved scores in the following English Language tests² as indicated:
 - 1. TOEFL: 550 (Paper-based)/79 (Internet-based/Home Edition);
 - 2. IELTS (Academic): 6.5 (Test Centre based/Online);
 - 3. GMAT: Band 21 (Verbal)³;
 - 4. GMAT Focus Edition: Band 78 (Verbal); or
- 3. obtained a pass grade in English in one of the following examinations:
 - 1. Hong Kong Advanced Level Examination (AS Level);
 - 2. Hong Kong Higher Level Examination;
 - 3. CUHK Matriculation Examination;
 - 4. General Certificate of Education Examination (GCE) Advanced Level (A-Level)/Advanced Subsidiary Level (AS-Level); or
- 4. achieved Level 4 or above in the English Language subject of the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education (HKDSE) Examination; or
- 5. obtained a recognized professional qualification⁴, provided that the examination was conducted in English.

Notes:

- 1. This is based on the understanding that English is the medium of instruction of degree programmes offered by universities in Hong Kong. Moreover, graduates from universities in Hong Kong should have fulfilled the English language requirements of the institution concerned when they were admitted to the degree programmes. The CUHK Graduate School may request applicants to provide additional supporting documents to prove their English proficiency.
- 2. TOEFL and IELTS scores are considered valid for two years from the test date. GMAT scores are considered valid for five years from the test date.
- GMAT (Verbal) Score with a threshold of 21 will be kept until the score validity phases out.
- 4. The programmes/Graduate Divisions shall at their discretion to determine if such professional qualification can be accepted
